# The Founding Constitution of the Diasporan Nation

## PREAMBLE

We the people of the Diaspora Nation, united by our heritage, resilience and the shared experience of living in the diaspora, have established this constitution to guide our nation and forge our own future.

Recognizing centuries of Struggles and Achievements of our ancestors across the world, we commit ourselves to unity, mutual aid, equality, justice, cultural preservation, and the protection of our citizens.

Through this Diaspora Nation Constitution we establish the laws, rights and responsibilities that shall govern all our citizens, ensuring that our community may prosper with dignity, solidarity, wealth and strength.

Our primary goal is to establish and fund Diaspora Businesses around the world, to ensure a self-sufficient economy that all Diasporans can utilise to benefit themselves and leave a great legacy for their loved ones regardless of their cultural, beliefs or non beliefs.

May the forces of the boundless universe be forever in our favour and may the founders of this nation and all citizens within, be always blessed with love, health and happiness in this life and the next.

## Article I

### Identity And Purpose Of The Diasporan Nation

The Diasporan Nation is an international cultural and civic community that represents people of African and Caribbean descent who are living in the diaspora as their permanent residence.

**This Nation exists to:**

- . Unite African and Caribbean descendants living across the diaspora
- . Promote mutual assistance and solidarity among citizens
- . Preserve and celebrate African, Caribbean and Diasporan heritage
- . Protect, serve, support and uplift Diasporan Communities worldwide
- . Encourage economic, educational & cultural advancement of citizens
- . Create jobs and entrepreneurial opportunities for our citizens globally

## Article II

### Diaspora Nation Citizenship

#### Section 1 - Full Citizenship

Full citizenship in the Diasporan Nation shall be granted to those who:

- . Are of Black African or Black Caribbean descent
- . Was born in the diaspora or have officially lived there for 9 years+
- . Taken the Diasporan Nation Oath of Allegiance
- . Pledge to uphold the Constitution of the Diasporan Nation

#### Section 2 - Nation Supporter Citizenship

Individuals of other racial cultures may join the community through our Nation Supporter Citizenship if adhering to the following criteria:

- . Must support the initiatives and activities of the Diasporan Nation
- . Must respect and follow the laws and values of the nation
- . Must commit 9 Years of service & commitment to receive full citizenship

#### Section 3 - Citizenship Through Marriage or Partnership

Any individual who is not of Black African or Black Caribbean descent but is legally married or in a long-term common law partnership with a full citizen of the Diasporan Nation, shall be automatically entitled to full citizenship, provided they:

- . Accept the Diasporan Oath of Allegiance
- . Agree to uphold the Constitution of the Diasporan Nation
- . Stay married or in common law partnership with their spouse



#### **Section 4 - Equal Treatment**

All citizens are equal under the values of the Diasporan Nation and must be treated with dignity and respect, without discriminating against another citizen on the basis of:

- . Religion
- . Sexual Orientation
- . Gender Identity
- . Cultural Background

#### **Article III - Rights of Citizens**

All Diaspora Nation Citizens have the right to:

- . Equal treatment for all within the Diasporan Nation
- . Mutual assistance from fellow citizens when possible
- . Participation in national initiatives and cultural events
- . Respectful expression of non-violent ideas & ideologies
- . Fair mediation & Representation in disputes with other citizens
- . Opportunities for education, collaboration and advancement

#### **Article IV — Responsibilities of Citizens**

All Diaspora Nation Citizens must at all times:

- . Uphold this Constitution
- . Respect all fellow citizens
- . Offer assistance to other citizens whenever able
- . Protect the security and reputation of the nation
- . Safeguard confidential national information
- . Promote unity within the diaspora

#### **Article V - Protection of Children**

Children of citizens are automatically Diaspora Nation Citizens and shall receive special protection. The safety and well-being of our children will always be a priority. All citizens share equal responsibility to:

- . Protect the children from physical or mental harm from others
- . Support their growth and development wherever possible
- . Provide assistance to families with children whenever possible
- . Notify the authorities or guardians if any child is in danger



## Article VI - Government of the Diaspora Nation

The Diaspora Nation will be guided by the Diaspora Council and shall:

- . Represent the interests of citizens
- . Interpret and uphold the Constitution
- . Guide national initiatives
- . Review citizenship applications
- . Resolve disputes among citizens

## Article VII - Security and Confidentiality

Any sensitive information relating to the Diaspora Nation must remain strictly confidential. Citizens are NOT PERMITTED to disclose sensitive information to non-citizens without first obtaining official authorization from the Diaspora Council. Violation of this rule will result in disciplinary action by the Diaspora Council.

## Article VIII – Passport & National Identification

A Diaspora Nation Passport will be issued to every citizen for a minimal cost, which will contain:

- . The Citizen's Full Name & Date Of Birth
- . Type of Citizenship held
- . Date Citizenship Oath was completed
- . Official seal of the Diaspora Nation
- . Signature of the Chief Steward

## Article IX - Amendments

This Constitution will continue to evolve as our Diaspora Nation evolves. Amendments to our Constitution can be proposed by any citizen which will be fully reviewed by our Diasporan Council before approval and may be subject to our Citizen Referendum Panel. Our Councilors will always endeavour to preserve the core principles of unity, equality, and mutual support that our nation embraces when approving any amendments.

## Final Declaration

Our Diaspora Nation Constitution has been created to help preserve our heritage and strengthen Diasporan Communities worldwide. Together we will secure a great future grounded in dignity, respect, wealth and Peace.



## The Diaspora Nation 1 Million Citizens Target 2027

All Citizens Are Required To Affirm The Following Oath Of Allegiance Before They Can Become A Diaspora Citizen... This Will Be Carried Out Via Zoom Group Call Every Last Sunday Of The Month @ 6.30pm UK Time.

- I** I pledge my allegiance to the Diaspora Nation and to uphold its values.
- II** I swear to always be ready to help fellow citizens whenever possible.
- III** I swear that I will treat every fellow citizen with respect at all times.
- IV** I swear to offer my service to the Diasporan Nation whenever possible.
- V** I swear never to divulge any sensitive information about the Diaspora Nation to anyone that is not a citizen without prior council permission.
- VI** I swear to treat every fellow Citizen equally to others at all times.
- VII** I swear never to discriminate against any Diaspora Nation Citizen's, religious beliefs, physical appearance, sexuality or human rights.
- VIII** I swear to always respect and protect the Diaspora Nation Flag.
- IX** I swear to offer any resources I have if possible to help fellow citizens.
- X** I swear to help guide & protect all children of the Diasporan Nation.
- XI** I swear to always help and protect our elderly Diaspora Citizens.
- X11** I have taken this oath of my own FREE WILL and pledge my loyalty to the founders of the Diasporan Nation and to its citizens therein.
